

Why We Are Needed...

A National Post poll showed that **93% of Canadians support the decriminalization of medical cannabis.**

Many people suffering from chronic or critical conditions in greater Victoria currently use cannabis to alleviate their conditions, yet under Health Canada's current program, there is no means for community-based access to medical cannabis and cannabis-based therapies.

The Vancouver Island Compassion Society (VICS) is a non-profit organization dedicated to providing a safe source of medical-grade cannabis to patients throughout and beyond Vancouver Island. We are also working to increase our knowledge and understanding of medicinal cannabis by initiating and participating in peer-reviewed research investigating the therapeutic potential of raw cannabis and other cannabis-based therapies.

Since 1999, the VICS has provided its members with a high-quality source of medicine within a safe, professional atmosphere that's conducive to healing.

Who Can Join the VICS?

There is irrefutable medical evidence that cannabis can alleviate many of the symptoms of the following conditions:

- **Nausea and vomiting:** associated with cancer and HIV/AIDS therapies.
- **Wasting Syndrome:** to stimulate appetite and produce weight gain.
- **Multiple Sclerosis:** for the relief of muscle pain and spasms.
- **Epilepsy:** to help reduce the frequency of seizures.
- **Glaucoma:** to lower intra-ocular pressure.
- **Hepatitis C:** to alleviate pain, itching and fatigue; to help with treatment.
- **Fibromyalgia:** to alleviate chronic muscle aches and fatigue.

As there is much anecdotal evidence that the symptoms of other conditions can be treated with cannabis use, (chronic pain syndromes, spasticity disorders...) the VICS will register any applicant with a valid medical recommendation for cannabis use.

Recent Medical Marijuana News

Starting April 1, 2014, the new Health Canada medical cannabis regulations (Marihuana for Medical Purposes Regulations, or MMPR) will be in full force. While the right to possess and use cannabis with a doctor's recommendation will be maintained, the right to cultivate at home has been revoked.

The new program consists of for-profit dried cannabis producers, licensed by Health Canada, who will sell their product to those with a doctor's recommendation, either through the mail or by courier. Again, medical cannabis dispensaries have been specifically excluded as a means of access.

Lawyer John Conroy, Q.C., is taking the lead on a constitutional challenge regarding the right to reasonable access to cannabis as medicine. This right arises as a result of Section 7 of the Charter of Rights.

Cannabis is safe:

The LD-50 (median lethal dose) of cannabis is between 1:20,000 and 1:40,000. An individual would have to smoke nearly 1500 pounds of cannabis within about 15 minutes to induce a lethal response. In 3000 years of therapeutic and recreational use there has never been a single reported death due to use or treatment or a single incident of lung cancer associated solely with cannabis inhalation.

Cannabis is medicine:

As a result of recent high court decisions and clinical research, the federal government has recognized the medical need of some critically and chronically ill Canadians for cannabis, and has proceeded with the cultivation and distribution of a single strain of poor quality, non-organic cannabis product.

It is imperative that patients presently struggling with life-threatening or incurable diseases have access to a safe, affordable supply of cannabis from an environment that is conducive to healing.
